Community Road Safety Grants Program Project Grant

Who can apply?

- Local Government
- Health Organisations
- Schools
- Service Clubs
- Youth Development Groups
- RoadWise Committees
- Organisations or groups that encourage active community participation in the planning and implementation of road safety programs
- Government agencies with demonstrated community support

Projects will be highly regarded focus on the four cornerstones of the Towards Zero, recommended WA Road Safety Strategy 2008 - 2020:

- Safe Roads & Roadsides
- Safe Speeds
- Safe Vehicles
- Safe Road Use

Projects will not receive funding if:

- They can be funded through Black Spot funding, Road funding, the Police STEP Program, Country Pathways Grants Scheme, Road Safety Council Research Advisory Group Funding;
- They are for capital works; or
- The agencies or organisations involved have statutory responsibility for the project initiatives.

Preference will be given to projects that:

- Focus on the four cornerstones outlined in the recommended WA Road Safety Strategy 2008-2020 Towards Zero;
- Relates to current road safety research
- Demonstrate clear relevance to the target group;
- Use an approach that has previously been successful in achieving road safety objectives;
- Demonstrate widespread community support and participation;
- Demonstrate sustainability;
- Provide a contribution in cash or kind towards the project;
- Demonstrate a regional focus for maximum impact.
